Drainage Board members present were: Kenny Hale, Don Adams, and Bryan Collier. Also present were Terry Brock (Surveyor), Bill Dials (Stormwater Coordinator) and Kerstin Woodard (Recording Secretary).

Pledge

Minutes

Mr. Collier made a motion to approve the 05/02/2022 minutes, Mr. Hale seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Old Business

Mr. Brock is still working with INDOT in regard to Hildale Cemetery Ditch. There has been no response from Mark Bailey, INDOT's Director of Hydraulics, at this time. Mr. Brock will reach out again today.

Mr. Dials stated that the Herbicide Applicator has been working for the last two weeks and everything seems to be going well.

New Business

The Surveyor's Office has received two complaints about Sun Valley Mobile Home Park located off of Outer Drive in Martinsville. Trailers were removed from the mobile home park and the remaining tarps, siding, and other debris were disposed of into Sartor Ditch. Mr. Brock and Mr. Dials investigated the site and a letter was sent to the property owners. The property manager has been in the Surveyor's Office and the property owner has been spoken to. Both the property manager and owner were told to clean up the ditch, keep debris out of the ditch and to keep the top of the banks clean as well.

Stormwater Update

Mr. Hale signed a copy of the MS4 NOI, enabling the Stormwater program to continue operating.

The Annual River Clean Up, last month, was a huge success. More than 60 volunteers participated, many were high school age. The Three Rivers location, a natural catch all area, filled a 15-yard dumpster. While Jackson's Junk volunteered a trailer, which was filled at the Henderson Ford Ramp area.

The White River Alliance has a canoe which has been painted by a local Morgan County Artist. The Public Educator will reach out to Mr. Hale about the possibility of displaying the artwork at Waverly Park. Along with the canoe, there will be a podcast; each of the clips on the podcast can be used towards our required education numbers.

Surveyor Update


Joint Drainage Board met in May, approving Westpoint. Work will be started to take in the new regulated drain, charging \$100.00 an acre; we will maintain the outlets.


Mr. Brock stated that he had been approached by a possible developer of parcels to the south of Flagstaff Business Park. Developers may eventually ask us to take in the next section of drain as regulated.
