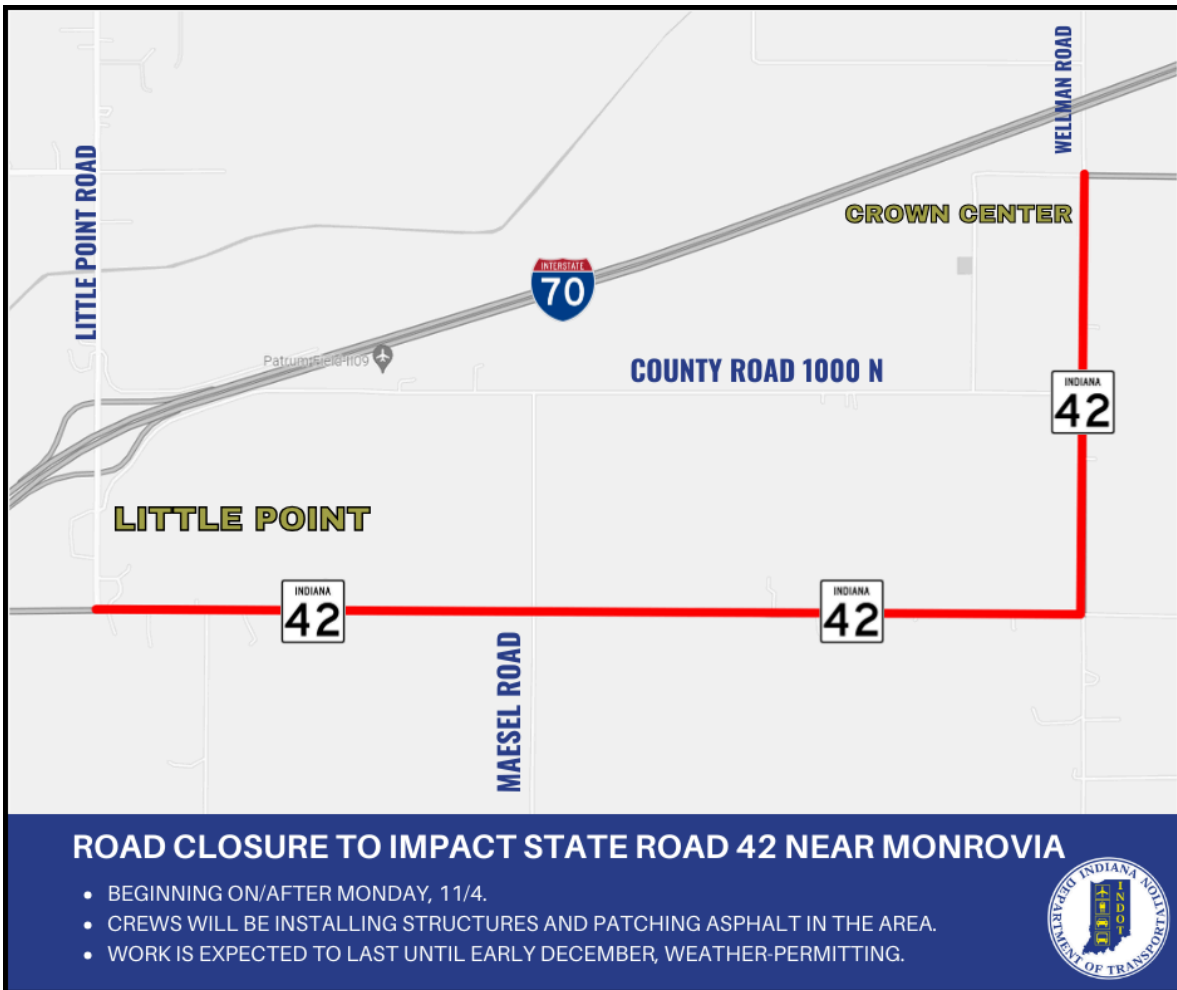

Road closure to impact State Road 42 near Monrovia

MORGAN COUNTY, Ind. - The Indiana Department of Transportation announces a temporary road closure on State Road 42, located between Little Point and Crown Center in Morgan County.

Beginning on or after Monday, Nov. 4, crews will be closing S.R. 42 between Little Point Road (County Road 1100 W) and Wellman Road (C.R. 875 W). The purpose of the closure is to allow crews to safely complete structure installations and asphalt patching.

Work is expected to last until early December but is weather-dependent and subject to change. The official detour around the project is S.R. 42 to S.R. 39 to S.R. 142 to S.R. 42. INDOT encourages drivers to seek an alternate route and use caution in and around all work zones.
