

MORGAN COUNTY REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

April 8, 2025 —Meeting Minutes

The Morgan County Redevelopment Commission met April 8, 2025 at 8:30am at the Morgan County Administration Building in Martinsville.

1. **Roll Call:** On the call of the roll the following Commissioners were shown to be present: Jeff Pipkin, Troy Sprinkle, Brad Shields, Kim Merideth and Carole Snyder. Dr. Jake Allen was absent. Attorney Steuerwald was absent. Project Manager Chelsey Manns was present.

Commissioner Snyder called the meeting to order and led the Commission in the pledge.

2. **Reading and Approval of the Minutes:** Public meeting minutes from March 11, 2025 were reviewed. Commissioner Merideth made the motion to approve minutes as presented. Commissioner Sprinkle seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.

7. Economic Development Update: Manns provided the April 15th report highlighting the events of the Commission for the 2024 calendar year. The report was presented to the Council and will be shared with the County Commissioners as well. Commissioner Sprinkle made the

motion to approve the April 15th report as presented. Commissioner Pipkin seconded the motion, which carried 5-0.

Manns shared that Martinsville Schools are looking to construct a new elementary school near the Henderson Ford interchange and requested assistance from the county regarding public infrastructure. Manns asked if the Commission had interest in her engaging in additional conversations regarding the Commission's participation. The Commission discussed having Manns follow up to learn more and asked her to do so.

8. **Other Business:** County Commissioner Kenny Hale provided a Waverly Parks update.

Commissioner Hale also shared he has been contacted by someone who is interested in purchasing some of the Commission's land. Manns expressed the statutory process for the disposal of property and that the commission is not yet there.



After some discussion, Commissioner Merideth made the motion to hold off on the new gate based on the fact that the Commission is interested in selling the land in the future. Commissioner Shields seconded the motion, which carried.


9. **Next meeting:** The RDC noted the next meeting of the Commission will be Tuesday, May 20, 2025 at 8:30am.






