Minutes

Mr. Voyles made a motion to approve the 09/04/2020 and 11/02/2020 minutes, Mr. Hale seconded the motion. Motion carried 2-0.

Stormwater Update

Mr. Dials thank Mr. Voyles for his time with the county and expressed that he will be missed. At the last meeting maintenance specs were approved for Flagstaff Regulated Drain. Mr. Dials said the work is being completed by Anderson Tree Company, it is coming along nicely and should be completed today (12/07/20).

Mr. Dials said that the Morgan County Partnership for Water Quality's river cleanup has been postponed until possibly March. A webpage has been set up for the Partnership (mcpwq.org) and the county can participate in a virtual cleanup by cleaning up trash in along a waterway and submitting a photo. The Partnership will provide a t-shirt to all whom participate. The Partnership's public educator, Rachel Peine, has also set up a Facebook, Twitter and Instagram page. The county is invited to adopt a drain, which participants will receive credit and a t-shirt for as well.

Surveyor Update

Mr. Brock and Mr. Dials have inspected where the 39 drain comes into Nutter Ditch, and it is not up to standards. Mr. Brock said that the banks have not been stabilized, the sod/stone does not look good, and the north side of the bank has not been armored. INDOT will be contacted to fix it. Mr. Brock said if INDOT does not take care of it, we will but will charge them a fee. Mr. Brock said he thinks the work was contracted through Gradex.

Mr. Brock said the MS4 Stormwater Construction Permit draft is in the public comment phase until January 25th. Mr. Brock also let the board know that his is unsure if it is complete, but that Low Head Dam is gone on White River.

Mr. Brock thanked Mr. Voyles and said it has been an honor and a privilege to work with him.


Adjournment




