Commissioner Sprinkle made the motion to nominate Carole Snyder as Vice President. Commissioner Merideth seconded the motion. Commissioner Elliott asked for other nominations. Commissioner Sprinkle made the motion to close nominations. Commissioner Merideth seconded the motion, which carried 4-0. The vote was taken for the nomination of Commissioner Snyder to serve as Vice President which carried 4-0.

V. Reports To The Redevelopment Commission

- A. Waverly Sewer Update Manns provided update per Bullock:
 - a. Manns provided an oral update from Bullock:
 - i. The SRF made a mistake on a previous disbursement request and paid Reed & Sons less than what they were owed in the amount \$4,084. SRF requested we submit a new disbursement request form for this amount which is attached. The payment was already approved correctly by the RDC so no formal action should be needed.

ii. Manns also noted that most of the final docs are finished and Bullock will be dropping off a thumb drive. There may be some additional documents from the Regional Sewer District but we will add those as they happen.

B. Legal Update

- a. Attorney VanLeeuwen provided the final snow removal agreement already executed by RMR to Commissioner Elliott for his signature.
- b. Attorney VanLeeuwen noted she will be working to update the RMR lease with the plat information and will deliver that to RMR as well as the Regional Sewer District.

C. Economic Development Update -

- a. Manns provided a broadband update and information from her written report including a Dropbox link of documents she's secured from providers and schools. She is expecting to provide a contract for consideration from Banning Engineering next month regarding GIS mapping to get a better visual of the pockets where we don't have coverage.
- b. Manns noted the continued work on Westpoint TIF. Numbers presented to attorneys and financial analysts by the developer don't match Hendricks County's numbers so they're waiting for clarification. In the meantime, Manns is working on the expanded TIF map.
- **c.** Manns Consulting 2022 contract was presented. Commissioner Snyder made the motion to approve the contact as presented. Commissioner Sprinkle seconded the motion which carried 4-0.

VI. Other Business

- A. Waverly Park Update County Commissioner Hale provided an update on Waverly Park. In addition to his update, he requested the remaining balance of the \$1M from the RDC for Waverly park which is \$90,744.24. A majority of those funds will be used for the log cabin, the Delaney House and the playground. A motion was made by Commissioner Merideth and Seconded by Commissioner Snyder to accept the report and request as made. The motion carried 4-0.
- VIII. Adjournment: Motion to adjourn received a second and was approved 4-0.

IX. Next meeting: The RDC noted the next meeting of the Commission will be February 14, 2022, at 8:30 a.m.
