On behalf of the Morgan County Health Department, we want to assure the public there is a plan in place for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). We are working closely with the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) and continue to stay updated on the status of the COVID-19 virus daily. Any recommendations passed along to us from the state will be acted upon.

The best way to protect yourself and your family is to:

- Stay home when you are sick.
- Contact your physician if you or someone in your family develops a fever, cough, difficulty breathing, or respiratory symptoms and tell your provider if you have traveled recently.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Older adults and people with underlying conditions should use extra caution in their day to day activities.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
