Terry Brock, Morgan County Surveyor, presented a letter of recommendation stating that Norman Voyles stated that the purpose of the meeting was to make a recommendation on the Lake bid and they all reported favorably. Kerns recently completed a \$6.4 million construction project for County Stormwater Coordinator, stated that he called the references listed on the Kern Excavating form, mathematical errors, and an incomplete plan and equipment questionnaire. Excavating submitted the lowest bid for Sections 2 and 3, but the bid submittal was deemed Excavating was the lowest bid for Section1 and the second lowest for Sections 2 and 3. proposed Lake Ditch (E R Robards) Project.
