Dear Farmer's Market Food Vendor:

This year, Morgan County has a new type of food permit for Farmer's Markets, specifically. This permit will cover all Farmer's Markets, including both regular season and winter markets. This permit will allow a vendor to be open more than the 15 days allowed by the Temporary Permit that was previously issued to you. This Farmer's Market permit will also cover the storage units used for your frozen/refrigerated meats and non-chicken eggs. The Morgan County Health Department may occasionally inspect these units as necessary, as well as the foods being sold on-site at the Farmer's Markets.

The 2022 fee for a Morgan County Farmer's Market Food Permit is **\$60.00** per unit. Please obtain a permit from this office PRIOR to the first event you plan to attend. In accordance with the Morgan County Food Establishment Ordinance, your permit shall be posted in plain view within your unit at all times while operating. If your permit is lost or forgotten between events, a new permit must be obtained at the annual fee of \$60.00 BEFORE sales commence.

A permit may be obtained by mail, online, or in person. Please complete the enclosed application and send **with a self-addressed, stamped envelope** with proper fee (check or money order) to the above address.
