Drainage Board members present were: Ryan Goodwin, Norman Voyles and Kenny Hale. Also present were Terry Brock (Surveyor), Bill Dials (Stormwater Coordinator), and Deb Verley (Recording Secretary). Jim Wisco (County Attorney) was not in attendance.

Pledge

Minutes

Mr. Goodwin said the 09/04/2020 meeting minutes will be considered at the next meeting.

New Business

Mr. Dials presented opening bids for Flagstaff Regulated Drain de-brushing. Clay Anderson submitted a bid of \$20,000, and John Anderson submitted a bid of \$12,000. Mr. Dials recommended using John Anderson. Mr. Brock requested to use General Drain Funds to pay for the Flagstaff Drain de-brushing. Mr. Hale made a motion to approve John Anderson and to use the General Drain Funds, Mr. Goodwin seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Stormwater Update

Mr. Dials said that the Morgan County Partnership for Water Quality has hired Rachel Peine as the new Stormwater Educator. Mrs. Peine has been working on the Morgan County Partnership for Water Quality website and social media accounts. The partnership's river clean-up will be December 12, 2020 beginning around 9 or 10 am at Three Rivers.

Surveyor Update

Mr. Brock submitted the 2021 Drainage Board submission and meeting schedules for approval. Mr. Hale made a motion to approve both schedules, Mr. Goodwin seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0
Mr. Brock said that the Joint Drainage Board project is on hold until next year. Nutter Ditch is not complete at this time, but has been seeded. IDEM has yet to put out the new MS4 and Rule 5 for public comments, which was supposed to be out in October.

Adjournment

Mr. Hale made a motion to adjourn, Mr. Goodwin seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
