Minutes

Stormwater Coordinator Update

Bill Dials, Morgan County Stormwater Coordinator, stated that the contractor removing the trees on Nutter Drain has submitted an invoice for payment. The drain looked good and work has been completed according to the specifications the drainage board issued.

North Madison Crossing Section 2 is under review and should be ready for signatures at the next meeting in April. This is in the buffer zone off Landersdale Road.

The Morgan County Partnership for Water Quality is working out the details and process for the public educator. They have a meeting coming up on Wednesday.

Surveyor Update

Terry Brock, Morgan County Surveyor, stated that a subdivision has been submitted to Hendricks County that will fall under the Joint Drainage Board jurisdiction. They will use the Hendricks County ordinance but do not yet have date for a Joint Drainage Board meeting.

The ditch assessments and classifications were to be presented but because of the recent rains, he was unable to get to some of the ditches and they should be ready for the next meeting.

INDOT has not submitted any new plan revisions for I-69.

Comments

A member of the public stated that he had an issue with a culvert and a muskrat. Bill Dials stated that he would look at the culvert and had a connection that could help with the muskrat issue.
