Stormwater Coordinator Update

Terry Brock, Morgan County Surveyor, stated that Bill Dials, Stormwater Coordinator, was not present. Mr. Brock stated that the Morgan County Partnership for Water Quality held the White River Clean-up on December 2nd and they filled a 15 yard dumpster completely full. This was an Eagle Scout project and at least 30 people participated. They worked in the Henderson Ford, Paragon and Three Rivers areas.

Surveyor Update

There are several spots that need work on Sedwick Ditch. There is not enough funding in the maintenance account for this ditch, but the cost can come from the General Drain Account and can be paid back as assessments come in.

Mr. Brock handed out pictures of Bayliss Drain on Lake Ditch. There is a beaver dam that is backing up the water to Lake Ditch. The trees have been removed, but the beavers are using cornstalks to build their dams. Mr. Brock will check into having the beavers trapped.

Mr. Brock stated that requests for spraying quotes will be sent out the first of the year. Lake Ditch looks good.

An obstruction removal hearing was scheduled for the meeting, but the petitioner pulled the complaint.


Minutes - 11/6/17
