Stormwater Coordinator Report

Bill Dials, Stormwater Coordinator, stated that they asked three contractors (Mike Knuss, David Quinn, and Rod Stafford) for quotes to remove a log jam in Mill Creek. They received one quote from Rod Stafford for \$7,980 to remove two log jams. There are several maple trees growing in a cluster; they will be cut low and the roots will remain in the bank.

Nutter Ditch is finished; they might have to put rip rap in a few places. There is new erosion occurring by the Humane Society. The water cut a vertical wall and it will need rip rap. It is within a few feet of the fence where the dogs are kept.

The Surveyor's Office accepted quotes for spraying vegetation along the regulated drains and the contractor will begin in two or three weeks.

The piles of debris and spoils have been removed along Cemetery Ditch and the project is complete.

They are in the final stages of rewriting the stormwater ordinance and will submit it to the Drainage Board for approval when it is complete and it will be made available so the public may make comments on it.

Surveyor's Report

Terry Brock stated that Banta Engineering provided maps for the two watersheds. They are still waiting on 39 Degrees North to update the website so this will be reflected on the parcels.
