Drainage Board members present were: Norman Voyles, Brian Goss, and Don Adams. Also present were: Brenda Adams (Auditor), Deb Verley (Administrative Assistant), and Pete Foley (County Attorney).

Ditch Update

Terry Brock, Morgan County Surveyor, stated that Lake Ditch has been completely dipped. The spoils have been knocked down and most of the fields are planted. All the tributaries have been cleaned and spoils knocked down. They are in the process of cleaning under the bridges.

Cemetery Ditch is complete. Mr. Brock inspected it after the last rain and the no water was standing in Artesian Acres or Indian Creek Village. They found an illicit discharge and notified the city.

Five beaver dams have been removed; three on Nutter Ditch and two on Sartor.

Mr. Brock stated that his office is working with the Soil & Water Conservation District, Johnson County Soil & Water, NRCS, and the Nature Conservancy in looking into a two-stage ditch for Sartor. The state will pay \$7.50 a foot to help in funding the ditch from Mahalasville to Indian Creek.

Minutes

Brian Goss made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 2, 2012 meeting. Seconded by Don Adams. Motion carried 3-0.

Hendricks / Morgan County Joint Drainage Board

Terry Brock stated that the Joint Drainage Board met last month. Brian Goss and Don Adams are on the board along with two members from Hendricks County and one from Parke County. They discussed drainage issues north of Mooresville and Mudd Creek drainage. The board motioned to do more study on the area north of Mooresville and hired Holloway Engineering. There will be another meeting in July and again in October.

Don Adams made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by Brian Goss. Motion carried 3-0.
