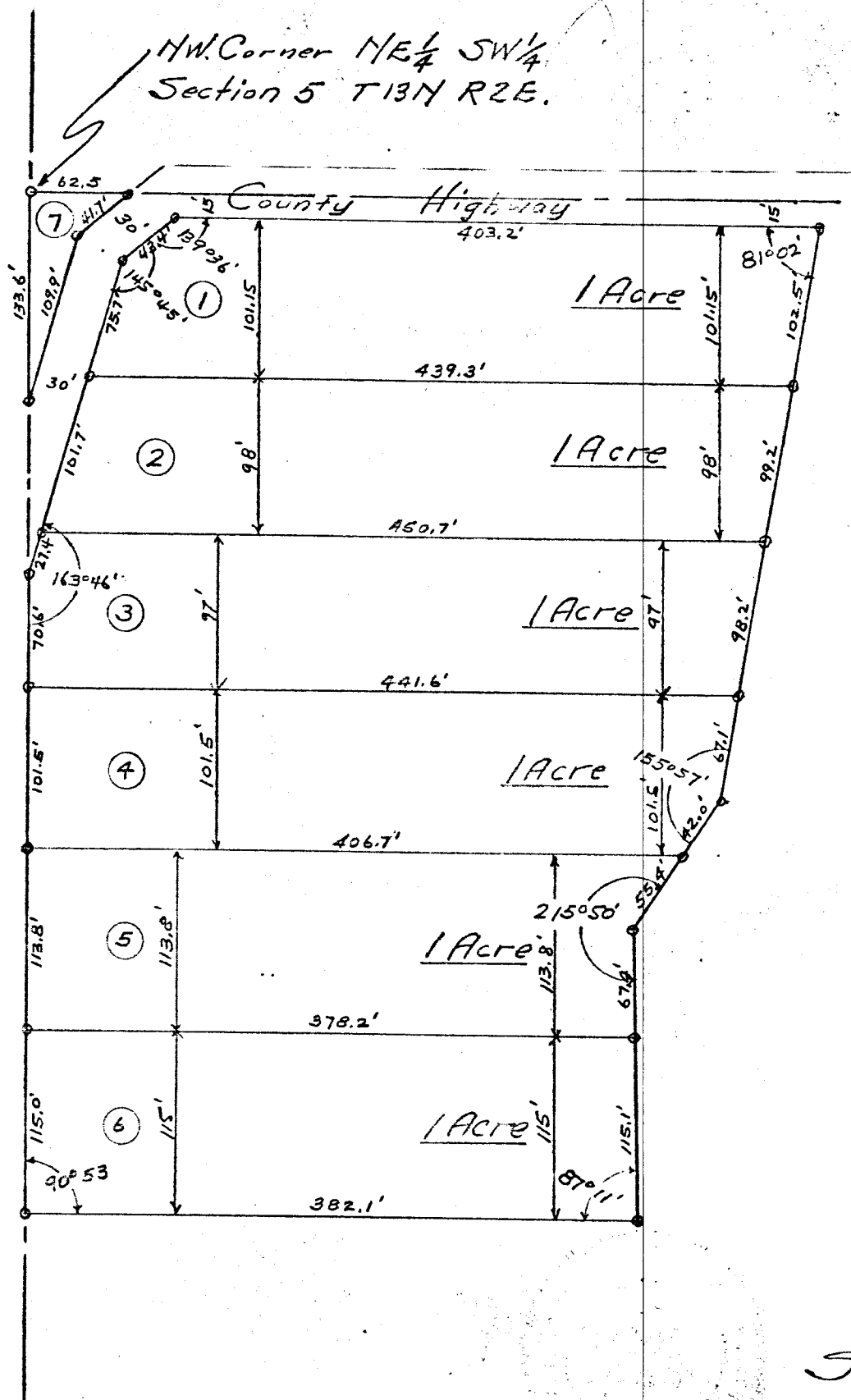

Engineer's Certificate

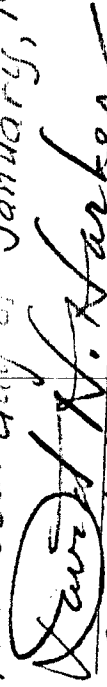
I, the undersigned, David H. Harker, do hereby certify that the accompanying plat is true and correct and represents a subdivision of the following described tract of real estate situated in Morgan County, Indiana, to-wit:

Part of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 5, Township 13 North Range 2 East of the 2nd Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows: beginning at a pipe monument at the northwest corner of said quarter-quarter; thence east on the east-and-west half-section line 493.5 feet; thence deflecting right 90 degrees and running 15 feet to an iron pipe; thence deflecting right 8 degrees 58 minutes and running 367.0 feet to an iron pipe; thence deflecting right 24 degrees 03 minutes and running 97.4 feet to an iron pipe; thence deflecting left 35 degrees 50 minutes and running 182.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence west parallel to the afore-said east-and-west half-section line 392.1 feet to an iron pipe on the west line of the afore-said quarter-quarter; thence north or said west line 644.0 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.34 acres, more or less.

This subdivision consists of seven lots numbered from 1 to 7, inclusive, as shown on the plat. Lot and highway dimensions are shown in figures denoting feet and decimal parts thereof, and angles are shown in degrees and minutes.

Lots numbered from 1 to 6, inclusive, are each one acre in area, and the common lot lines, which are those running east and west, are all parallel to the east-and-west half-section line of Section 5, which line is the centerline of the county highway lying along the north side of the subdivision. Lot number 7 is a small lot lying northwest of the highway, with dimensions as shown, and containing approximately 0.07 acre.
