And the said Natharine being of full age and being by me duly examined separate and apart from her said husband and the parties of the said Indenture being made known to her declared that she relinquished all her right and title of dower in and to the lands and tenements in the within Indenture set forth and described and that she voluntarily and of her own free will and accord and without coercion or compulsion of her husband signed sealed and delivered the said Indenture as her act and deed for the purpose aforesaid given under my hand and seal this 8th day of September 1897
