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

RECORD DESCRIPTION

LOT 17 IN PRATHER'S THIRD SUBDIVISION, AS PER PLAT
 THEREOF RECORDED IN DEED RECORD 154, PAGE 560, IN
 THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF MORGAN COUNTY, INDIANA.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT

In accordance with Title 264, Article 1.1, Chapter 19, Section 18(b)(1), Indiana Statutes, the surveyor certifies that the following observations and opinions are submitted regarding the various measurements and descriptions of the land surveyed established on this survey as a result of:

- a) Random errors in measurement (Theoretical Uncertainty);
- b) Variations in the reference datum; and;
- c) Discrepancies between descriptions and plots; and;
- d) Inconsistencies in lot descriptions.

The Theoretical Uncertainty (due to random errors in measurement) of the corners of the subject tract established in this survey is within the specifications for a Class B Survey (0.25 foot) as defined in IIC 304.

This survey is a "Metrasuburb Survey" as defined in IIC 304, of Lot 17 in Prather's Third Subdivision per plat thereof recorded in D.R. 154, p. 560, Office of the Recorder, Morgan County, Indiana.

The plat of the subdivision shows iron pins along Burton Road at the corners of lots 1 and 14. Iron pins were found this survey along the southwest and northeast corners of lot 14, the southeast corner of lot 11. The southwest corner of lot 1 is the point of beginning of the subdivision of the subdivision. The record distance to the point of beginning from the northwest corner of Section 10 is 108 rods(1732 feet). An iron pin was found 172.11 feet south of the northwest corner of Section 10, and 0.88 feet east of the section line. Also, the iron pin found at the northeast corner of lot 11 and 0.00 feet east of the section line.

These found iron pins are the only remaining physical evidence of the location of the subdivision boundary. Therefore, the found iron pins were used to establish the east-west line of the subdivision using the record angles shown on the plat. The east-west line is the extended east-to-intersection of the west line of Section 10. All lines of the subdivision were established using the found corners and the record distances and angles from the plat.

No inconsistencies in lines of occupation or discrepancies in record descriptions and plots were found.
