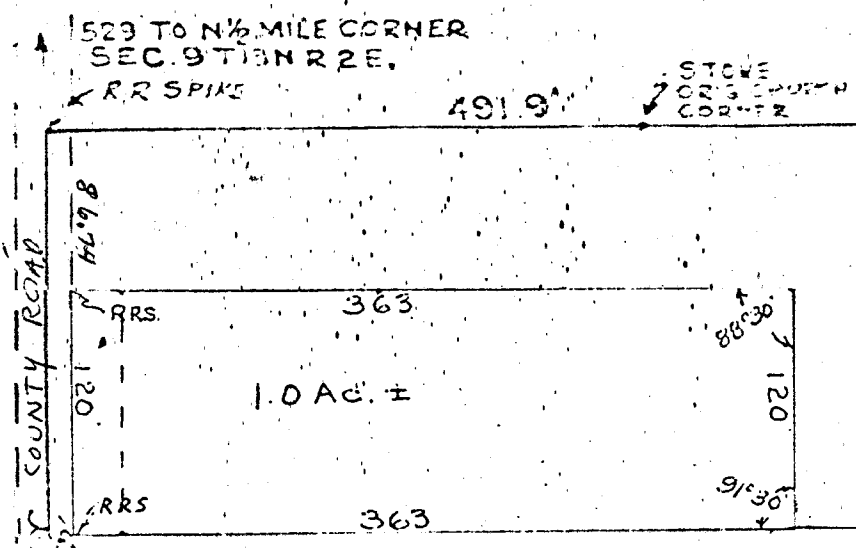


DALLAS TURPIN

A part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 13 North, Range 2 East, of Morgan County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows; to-wit: Beginning at a railroad spike in the County Highway and on the West line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 9 which is 529 feet South of the North half Mile Corner of the Section and running thence East parallel with the North line of the Section for 491.9 feet to an iron pipe; thence running North 100 feet to an iron pipe; thence continuing East parallel with the North Section line for 343.66 feet to an iron pipe; thence running South parallel with the mid line of the Section for 306.74 feet; thence running West parallel with the North line for 835.56 feet; thence North 206.74 on the West line of the Northeast Quarter Section and along the highway to the place of beginning, containing 4.5 acres more or less, subject to all legal highways and rights of way.

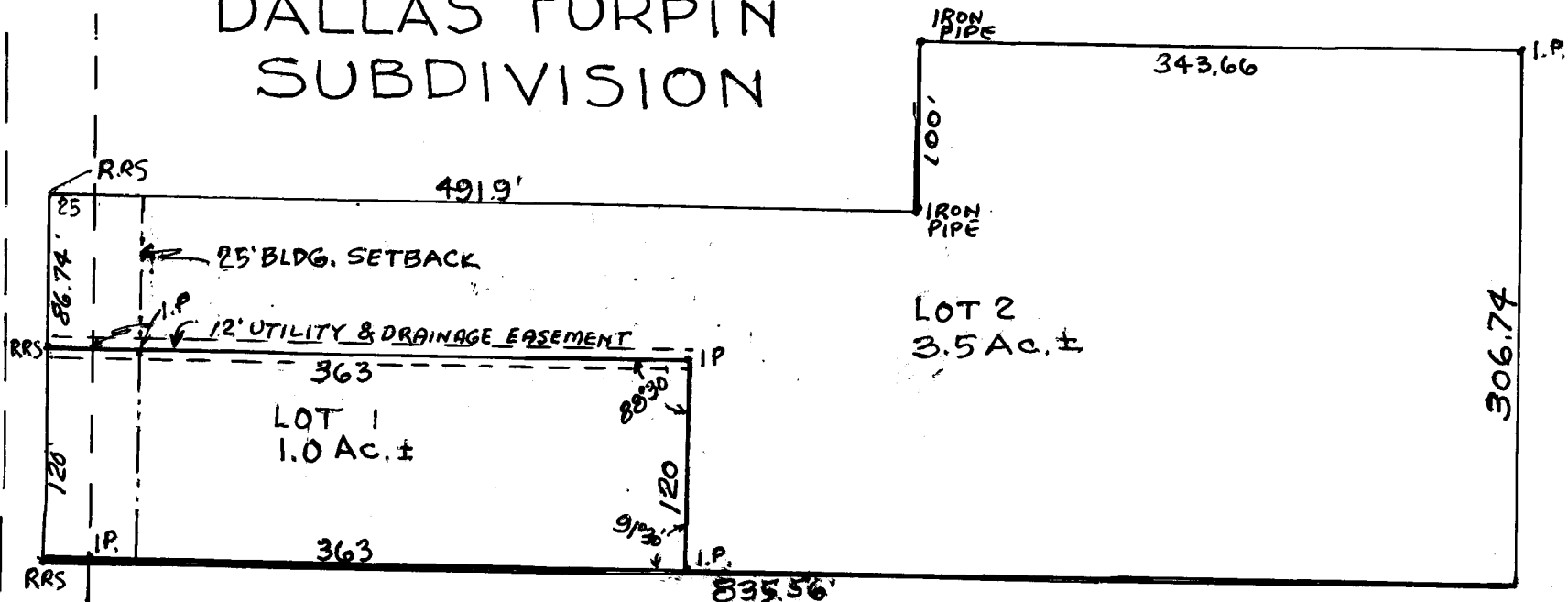
