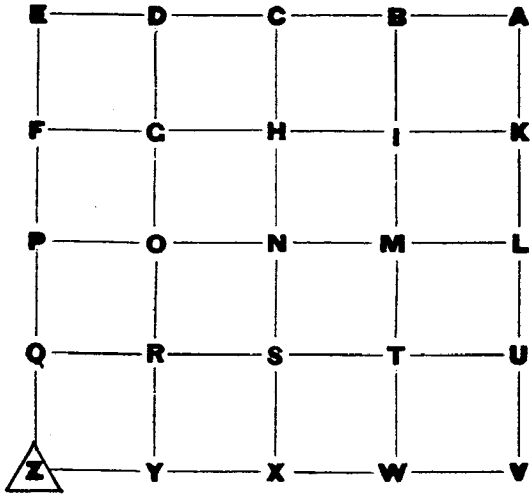


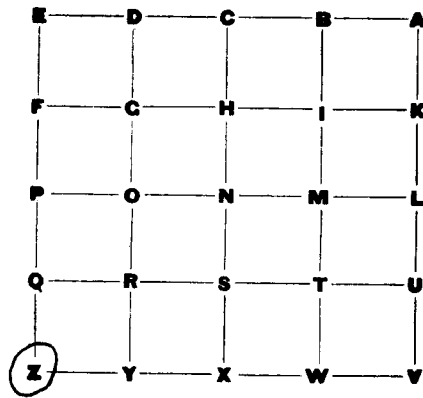

Field Crew - Rick Tapp, Pat Lashbrook, Daniel Powell, & Robert E. Burdick

(Pt #14) [Found] - Flat, triangular cut & shaped sandstone. Stone measures 5" on it's short sides & 6" on it's long side. It is 14" below Road Surface and Approximately 8" West of Center-Line of Jordan Road. Probe Depth of stone is Approximately 16" & has sandstone, cone shaped Coverstone over it. $\frac{3}{8}$ " rebar placed on North side of Stone.

(Pt #12) Set Type "A" Concrete Monument (Reference) $S69^{\circ}21'53''E - 19.59'$ (Astronomical)
 (Pt #13) Set Type "A" Concrete Monument (Reference) $S12^{\circ}19'32''E - 78.84'$

Before digging for the stone a railroad spike was observed which was North $24^{\circ}59'$ East 0.14 feet from the stone found.
