

THE MORGAN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, MORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL, AND MEMBERS OF THE MARTINSVILLE CITY COUNCIL MET IN A JOINT SESSION ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2020 AT 4:00 P.M.

MARTINSVILLE DOWNTOWN ACTION PLAN


Kenny Costin, Martinsville Mayor, requested that the entities listed above meet to discuss the Martinsville Downtown Action Plan and introduced Ken Remensneider, Brandon Shreeg, and Drew Wolfred with Kimley Horn. Mr. Remensneider stated that they started the project in November of 2018 and it was adopted into the City of Martinsville's Comprehensive Plan in August 2019. There have been 16 engagement meetings, seven of which were public meetings and they now have an estimate of the costs to present. Mr. Schreeg introduced Ben Rawlins, OMS. Mr. Schreeg stated that there are several different components of the plan and reviewed the phases. Plans include streetscapes, a performance park and renovation of the Courthouse Square. The cost is estimated to be \$17,650,000 over five years in five phases.

Discussion included downtown parking, maintenance of restrooms, lights, activity planning and public input. Mayor Costin asked the county for help in funding the project. No action was taken.






